# HOW TO PAINT IN WATERCOLOR

## MATERIAL LIST

Here is my recommended supply list for this class.  
But if you have watercolor supplies bring them and I can take a look.

### PAINT (tube paints only)

*\*Recommended brands: Danial Smith, Holbein, Winsor & Newton Professional (NOT Cotman), MaimeriBlu, M. Graham, Da Vinci, Blick Artists', or Royal Talens: Van Gogh, or Rembrandt*

Cobalt Blue  
Ultramarine Blue  
Manganese Blue  
Raw Sienna  
Burnt Sienna  
Alizarin Crimson  
Cadmium Yellow Medium  
Sap Green  
Olive Green

### BRUSHES (I prefer real hair watercolor brushes if you can afford them.)

1" flat brush  
#10 round  
#4 or #6 round brush

### PALETTE

\*\*Fusion watercolor palette by Mijello  
or

1 Enamel 11" x 14" butcher's tray  
and

Any 16-cell slant tray

\*DO NOT buy hobby store brands

\*\*I personally prefer this palette because it's easy to transport

\*\*\*Cut full sheets of watercolor paper into quarters

\*\*\*\*If you can't afford a tabletop easel prop-up your painting board with a roll of toweling paper

### PAPER

18" x 24" drawing board (Not needed if you are using a watercolor block)

\*\*\*1 sheet Arches bright white or natural white watercolor 300# paper: 22" x 30" – cold press

or

\*\*\*1 sheet Fabriano 300# watercolor paper: 22" x 30" – cold press

or

Arches natural white 300# cold press watercolor block, 10" x 14" or 12" x 16"

### ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES

3/4" masking tape (NO colored tape)

2B pencil and an ebony pencil

Kneaded eraser

X-Acto knife

Paper towels

Small water spray bottle

Sponge

Water container

Old toothbrush
